

**EFFECTIVENESS OF E-LEARNING IN ACQUIRING ENGLISH LANGUAGE  
SKILLS – AN OVERVIEW**

In total the process of developing e- learning content and software development is similar and same. In the process of e- learning various tools viz. synchronous communication modes like videoconferencing, virtual classroom, e-tutoring, etc, Asynchronous communication modes viz. e-mails, etc, Webinars, Interactive web pages, social networking, assessments, rapid e- learning, etc

are involved. There are different types of e-learning which includes online learning, blended learning, virtual classroom and mobile learning, etc. All these types helps to acquire the language skills in one way or other.

### **Effectiveness of e-learning**

When designing e-learning instructions, instructional designers, instructors, and e-learning developers have a learning outcome in mind that they want to accomplish. Their aim is to develop instructions and use technologies to create learning environments that are effective in fostering learning. The effectiveness of e-learning is marked by its ability to achieve statistically significant effect on improving learners' knowledge or skills. It's no doubt that e-learning helps the learner to adopt self – study techniques, motivates learning, have flexibility in using media, etc.

### **Role of e- learning in enhancing listening skill**

The term listening means 'to pay attention to'. This is the language skill which a child involves in first. The new born baby pay attention to the happenings around. The things which are listened will be stored in the mind. The child listens to the voice and sound around him and acquires the pronunciation, intonation, stress, and all other language aspects through listening. By listening to e- learning modules the learner,

- Understands the everyday English which he intends to speak
- Understands the concept of constructing English sentence structure
- Differentiates the vowel and consonant sounds in English
- Acquires knowledge in stress, intonation, etc

### **Role of e- learning in enhancing Speaking skill**

The child starts speaking after listening to the parents and neighbours around him. The child also develops the art of narration, description, defining, requesting, suggesting, comparing, classifying, etc after listening to someone. E-learning module helps to

- speak English like the native English speakers
- develop an international intelligence in his presentation

- have proper stress and intonation in speech
- communicate easily with rich language abilities
- enhances the ability of expression in simple language

### **Role of e- learning in enhancing Reading skill**

This is the third language skill which a student practice. Usually the students learn reading by listening to their teachers. In lower classes the students get practiced in listening to loud reading by the teacher. But in higher classes they will be listening to different types of reading like skimming, scanning, extensive reading, intensive reading, etc. With the help of e-learning the students get exposed to visualize various language experts involving in the art of reading. E-learning modules help to enhance the reading skill of the learner in following ways.

- Read at a normal speed
- Read with proper eye- movements
- Acquires knowledge in silent reading, loud reading, model reading, extensive reading, intensive reading, skimming, scanning, etc.
- develops the habit of attention and get trained in absorbing ideas quickly.

### **Role of e- learning in enhancing Writing skill**

Writing is an art. It is evidential hence all the documents, records, rules, regulations, etc are in written form. Writing needs lot of practice and requires creativity and critical thinking.

Writing is defined as “a graphical representation of language”

E-learning modules helps to develop this art of writing in various ways. There are various contents and presentations in the content form. This e- learning modules provides idea to

- make different shapes of the letters.
- use proper capitalization, punctuations, etc
- organize sentences, paragraphs, compositions, etc

- overcome grammatical errors in writing
- build vocabulary.

### **Merits of acquiring language skills using e- learning**

ICT is playing a prominent role in learning. ‘ICTs do not produce learning: technology is a tool that can be used in many ways, to enhance learning. There are three major categories of instructional use for computer – based technologies: these are i) learning from technologies: ii) learning about technology: and iii) learning with technology’.
